Message from the Director

The mission of Connections to Care is to connect with older adults and help them care for their health and maintain independence.

Since 2006 Connections to Care has enabled countless older adults to be as healthy and connected as possible. How? Simply by providing them with a ride. A ride to the doctor, dentist, lab, physical therapy, diagnostic testing, or minor procedure. All provided by our caring, compassionate volunteer drivers.

In 2023 Connections to Care continued the tradition of serving the needs of older adults in 14 Northwest suburbs. This year also saw these achievements:

- Awarded Non-profit organization of 2023-Arlington Heights Chamber of Commerce
- A balanced budget
- A successful Annual Appeal
- 70 new riders
- 20 new drivers

Although we provide services to all seniors 60+, our average age is 86. And this segment of the population is predicted to triple by 2040. In the future, older adults will require greater assistance and need organizations like Connections to Care even more.

Many of you may be familiar with the beloved children's book "The Little Engine that Could" which originated in the 1920's.

As the story goes, a stranded train carrying a heavy load is unable to find an engine willing to take it over difficult terrain to its destination. Only the little engine, a small steam engine, is willing to try. While repeating the mantra "I think I can, I think I can", he overcomes a seemingly impossible task and pulls the train up the mountain to the other side.

Connections to Care is that "little engine".




